

Master Money in Pence

Rationale

In this step, pupils build on their understanding of the value of coins from Year 1 to identify amounts of money in pence.

Pupils will develop their learning by identifying amounts of money in pence where the reverse side of some or all of the coins are shown.



Key Stem Sentences

Common Errors or Misconceptions

- Pupils may miscount the number of coins and identify the amount incorrectly.
- Pupils may not identify the reverse side of the 10p, 5p, 2p and 1p coins correctly.



Key Representations

Coins



There is one 50p coin and two 2p coins.
The amount is 54p.



There are three 10p coins, one 5p coin and one 1p coin.
The amount is 36p.



There are two 20p coins, one 5p coin, one 2p coin and two 1p coins. The amount is 49p.

- explain their understanding using written sentences, concrete apparatus and given representations.
